As you review these floor plans, please note that dimensions and configurations may vary by residence.

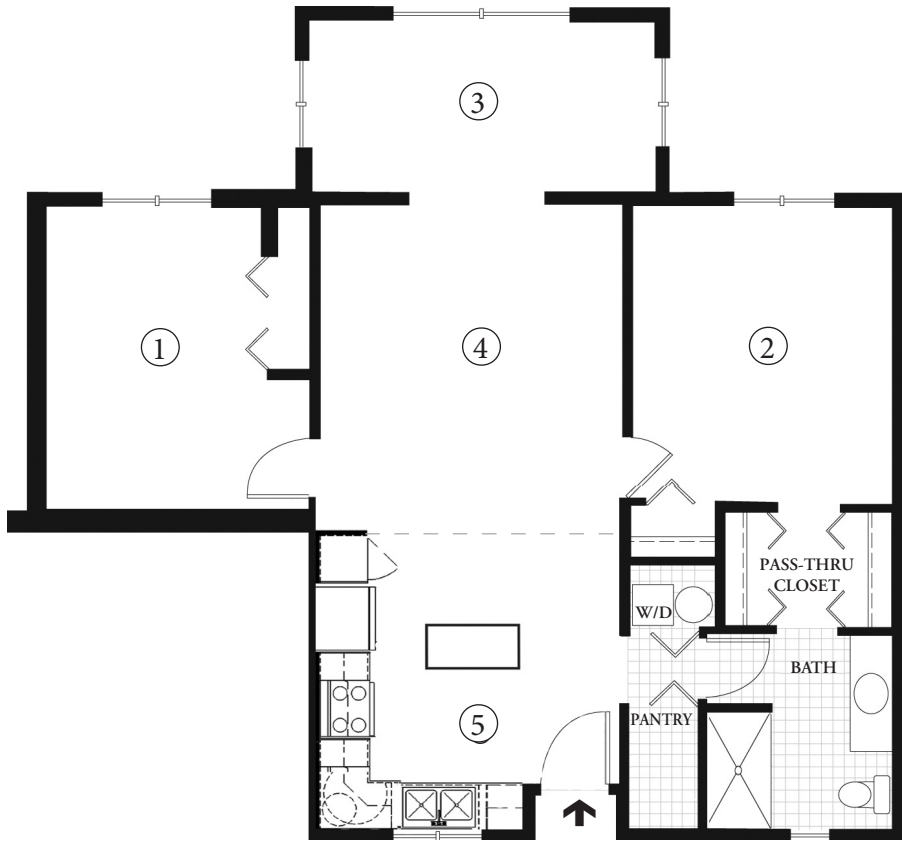


Cottage *Floor Plans*

Dogwood



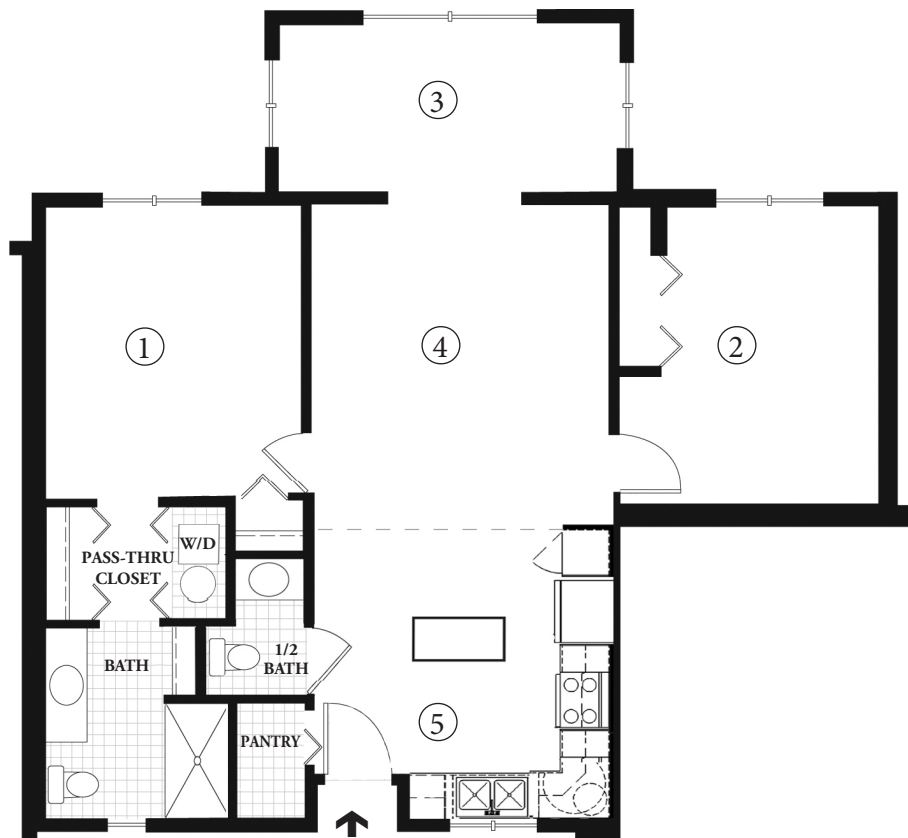

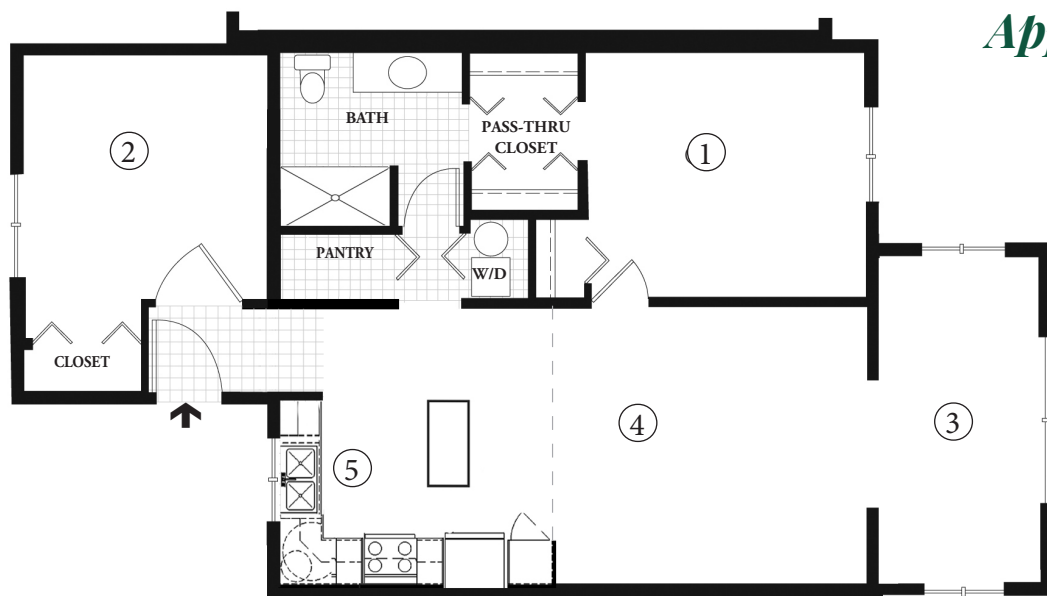

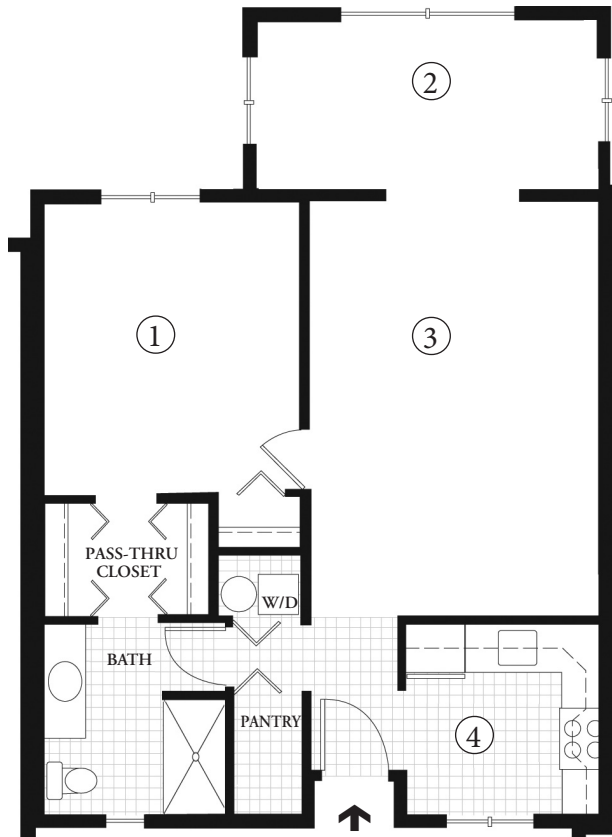

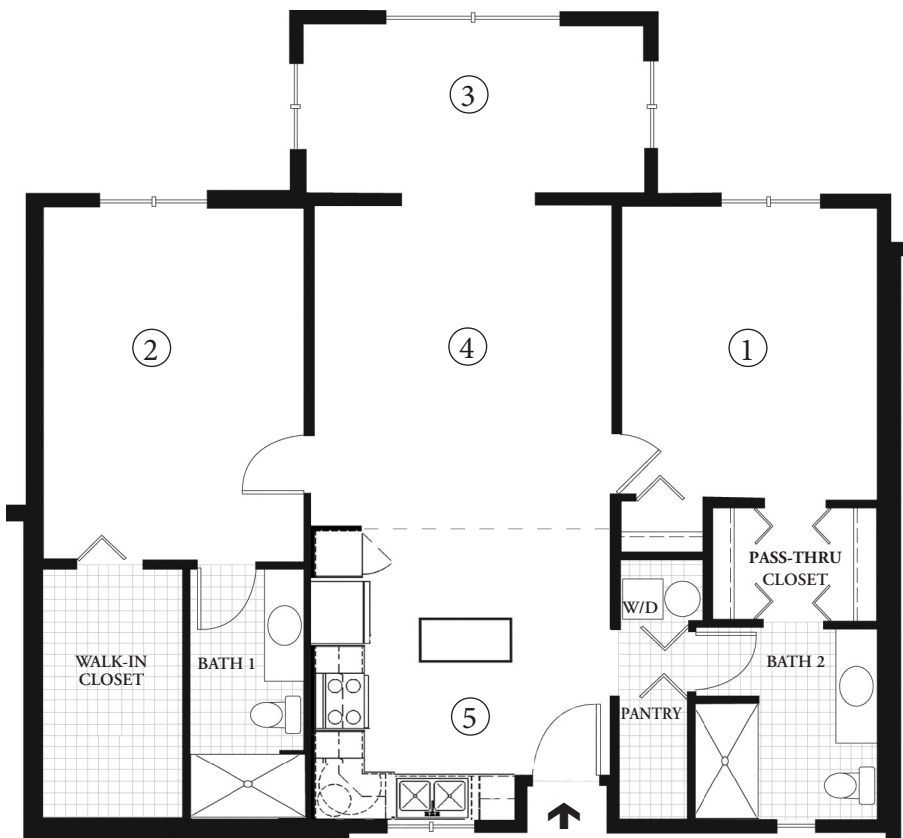

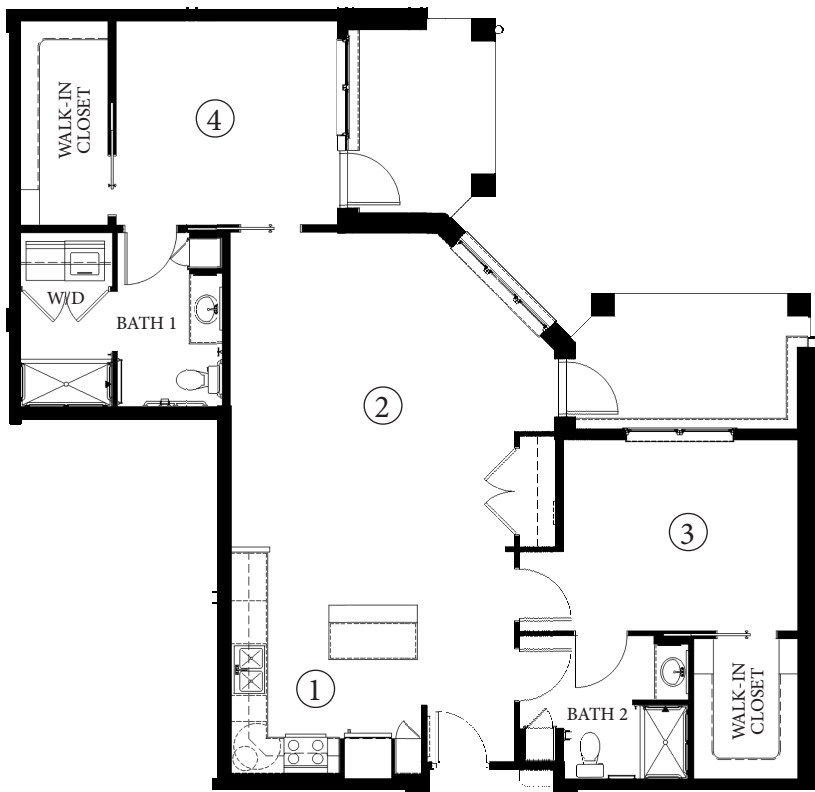

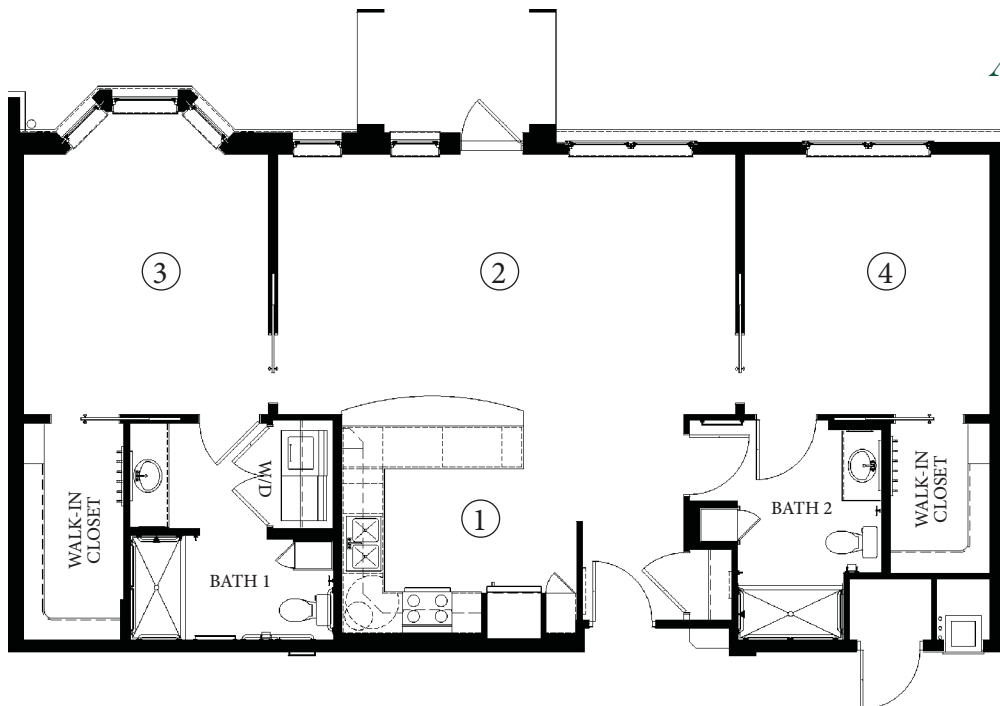

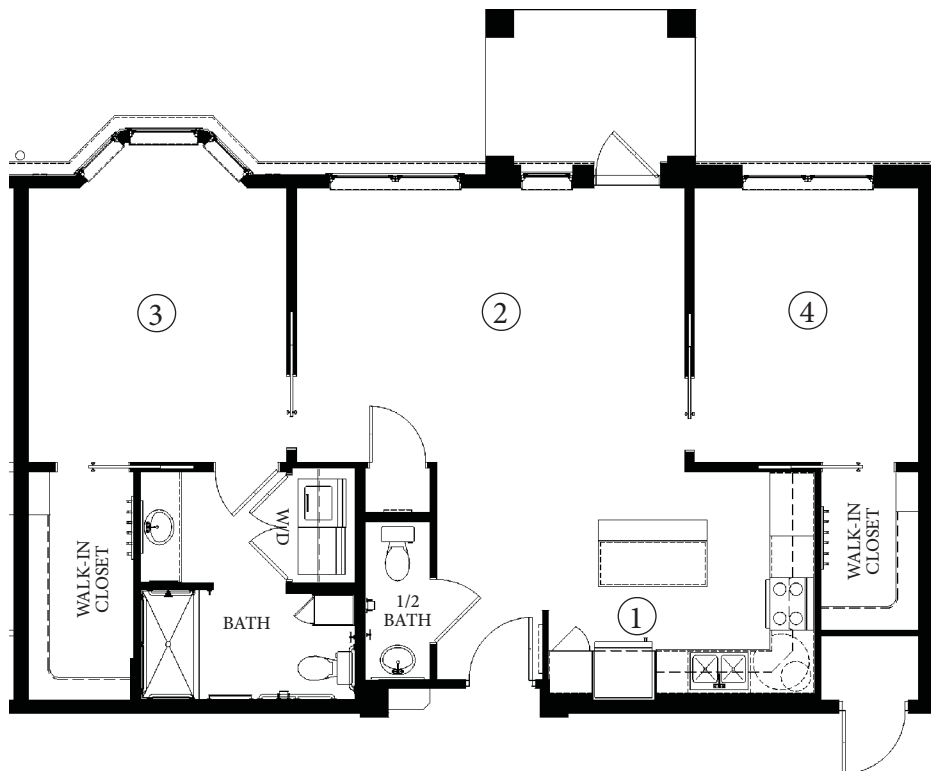

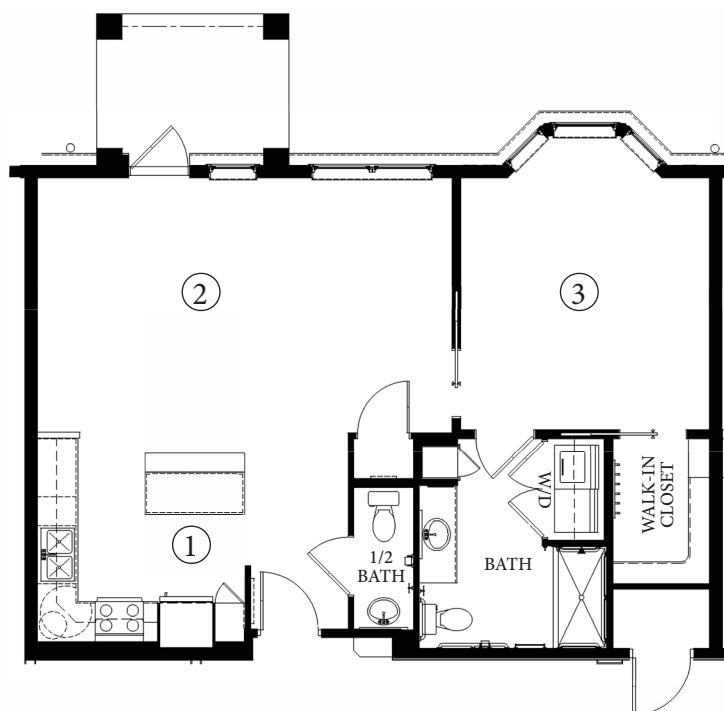
